

## **GREEN PHASE - The following pool rules are in effect beginning Friday, June 5, 2020**

The following are the pool usage rules as they apply to COVID-19, CDC requirements, State Government and Local Government Guidelines as of June 5, 2020. (subject to change)

These pool rules will remain in effect until new policies are posted. Adams Ridge has opened the community pool and will remain in a fluid state so that pool occupancy and rules can change throughout the summer. We will review all state, local and CDC guidelines daily and make changes as quickly as we can.

Please keep in mind that these rules may relax as the days and weeks go by and new information is distributed. We will review the pool usage rules on a daily basis and make changes.

The rules are set in place to protect our ARHOA community, residents and the pool staff. We thank you for honoring the pool rules and appreciate your patience as we work through the summer 2020 season.

### **GREEN Phase Rules:**

- Green Phase Pool Occupancy: 250 patrons at any time. (includes swimmers and non-swimmers)
- NO Sign Up Required:
  - There is no sign up required and no time limit for pool patrons. If you see residents waiting to enter the pool and you are done swimming please vacate the area. We want to allow all residents the opportunity to utilize the pool.
- No Pool Floats (rafts) at this time. This will be continually reviewed.
  - **Toys are allowed** including noodles, kick boards, balls, dive toys etc.
  - You may wear aquatic approved float vests and goggles.
- ARHOA pool chairs will be limited to 50 lounge chairs and 15 Adirondack chairs.
  - Patrons will be responsible for sanitizing the chairs should they want to use them. Sanitization spray and paper towels will be provided for you.
  - Patrons are welcome to bring your own chair to the pool.
- All children ages 14 and under must be accompanied by a supervising adult while at the pool until 6/19/20. This will revert to age 12 on 6/19/20 in the green phase.

### **Things to note:**

- Toys are allowed including noodles, kick boards, balls, dive toys etc.
- The slide will be turned on.
- The basketball pool hoop will be set up.
- Guest passes can be used.
- Pool Rentals are allowed.

### **Things to remember:**

- Patrons must maintain a 6ft. social distance.
- Parents are responsible for their own children at all times.
- Swimmers should NOT wear masks.
- Please be aware that lifeguards will NOT be wearing masks while guarding the pool or working on the pool deck.
- Pool Patrons may choose to wear a mask if they wish but are not required to wear a mask on the pool deck.
- Bathrooms – please limit bathroom use to 1 family at a time.

Final note: This is a unique time, please remember to respect the lifeguard staff and be neighborly. We are all working through this together and doing the best we can to open the pool and keep everyone safe.
