The Adams Ridge Community consists of 893 resident dwellings. Sending notification out to our residents can be a costly endeavor. It is the intention of the Adams Ridge Home Owners Association Board to reduce the amount of postal mail that is sent out while still increasing our communication efforts. With the new change in our property management we believe this will be a good time to ask our residents to engage in opting in to email communication.

Our newly renovated website allows us the opportunity to place all communication online and send information via email. Beginning in November 2014, we will adopt a monthly newsletter style of communication. This information will be available on our website and sent via email the first week of each month. This information will consist of community events, neighborhood happenings (such as asphalt resurfacing, landscaping dates, etc.), any township or newsworthy items, and any other items that would be of importance to our residents.

Email communication also grants us a mechanism to get essential information or emergency notification to you in a timely manner.

In order to receive this monthly communication we encourage you to sign up on our website. The ***Sign Up for Adams Ridge HOA Communication*** option is on our home page. You may sign up as many email addresses as you'd like. For those of you who have already signed up, Thank You! We know this will assist us in getting more information out to our residents.

This also means that effective, November 1, 2014 the only item that will be sent out via postal mail, will be the annual homeowner meeting notification as outlined in the bylaws.
