

ON STREET PARKING UPDATE

Dear Home Owners,

On Thursday, May 8, 2014 the Adams Ridge Home Owners Association (ARHOA) Board was notified by the Adams Township Police as follows...

Effective May 25, 2014, residents of Adams Ridge will no longer be calling the Adams Township Police Department requesting on-street parking nor will they be calling the 9-1-1 Center. It will now be the responsibility of the homeowners associations in Adams Ridge to issue on-street parking permits to their residents. Please notify your residents of this change.

At his time the ARHOA Board is assessing the situation of how permits might be distributed in the future. Given the short notice of this change, effective May 25, 2014 on street parking will be prohibited as outlined by the current posted parking ordinance. The Home Owners Association will work to seek solutions to issue such permits in the future.

If the ARHOA Board finds a suitable way to issue parking permits, this information will be posted on the Adams Ridge website www.adamsridge.net and will not be mailed to each resident via the US Postal Service.

Until further notice, please park at your own risk. Adams Township Police will ticket vehicles in violation of the posted on street parking ordinance.
